

FUNERAL

Scheduling

Preparation

The family of the deceased will meet with the presiding priest. The priest will assist the family in picking out music and scripture readings for the funeral. If the family wishes to have a luncheon, the parish office will contact the luncheon coordinator, who will then contact the family directly. Lectors must be Catholic. The priest or music director must approve all music choices.

Visitation

- Same day visitation starts at 10am with the funeral directly following at 11am.
- **Two-day** visitation may be scheduled for the evening before the funeral for a fee of \$300. The facility usage is limited to a maximum of 4 hours.

Fees

Organist: \$200Vocalist: \$150

Church Facility: \$250 or \$500 if no Funeral Director

Priest: Free-Will Offering

• **Luncheon**: All food is ordered and paid for by the family through a vendor of the family's choice. The St. Thomas Women's Club pays for the punch, coffee, pickles, and the delivery fee for the food. The Funeral Chair coordinates bars and desserts (which are provided by parishioners).

CEMETERY BURIAL

St. Thomas the Apostle Cemetery

- **Cemetery plot:** \$500 for registered parish members, \$1,000 for non-members. Maximum of two burials per plot, with at least one being cremains. Checks should be made out to *St. Thomas Cemetery*.
- **Grave opening/closing**: \$850 for a casket and \$350 for an urn. Coordinated and paid directly with the digging contractor. Please note that there is an additional \$100 cost during the winter months.
